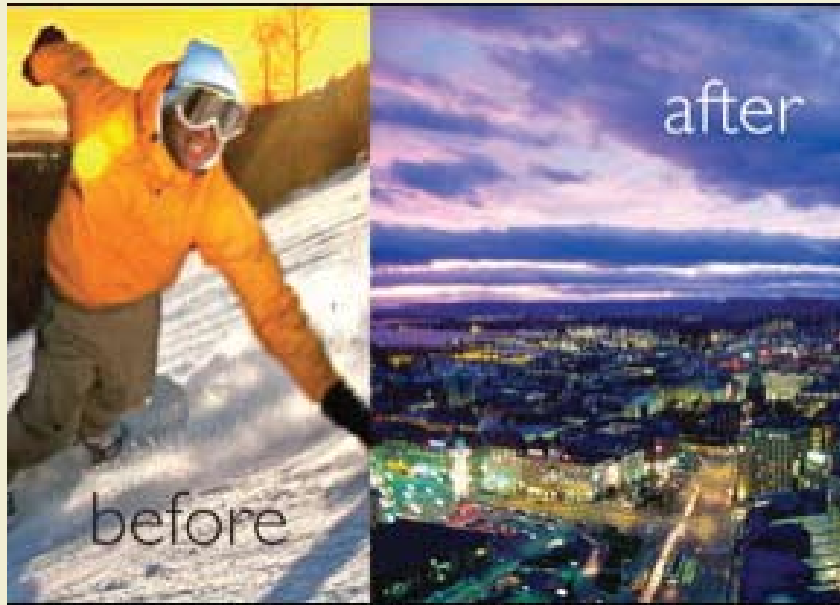






# Cruise destination Oslo

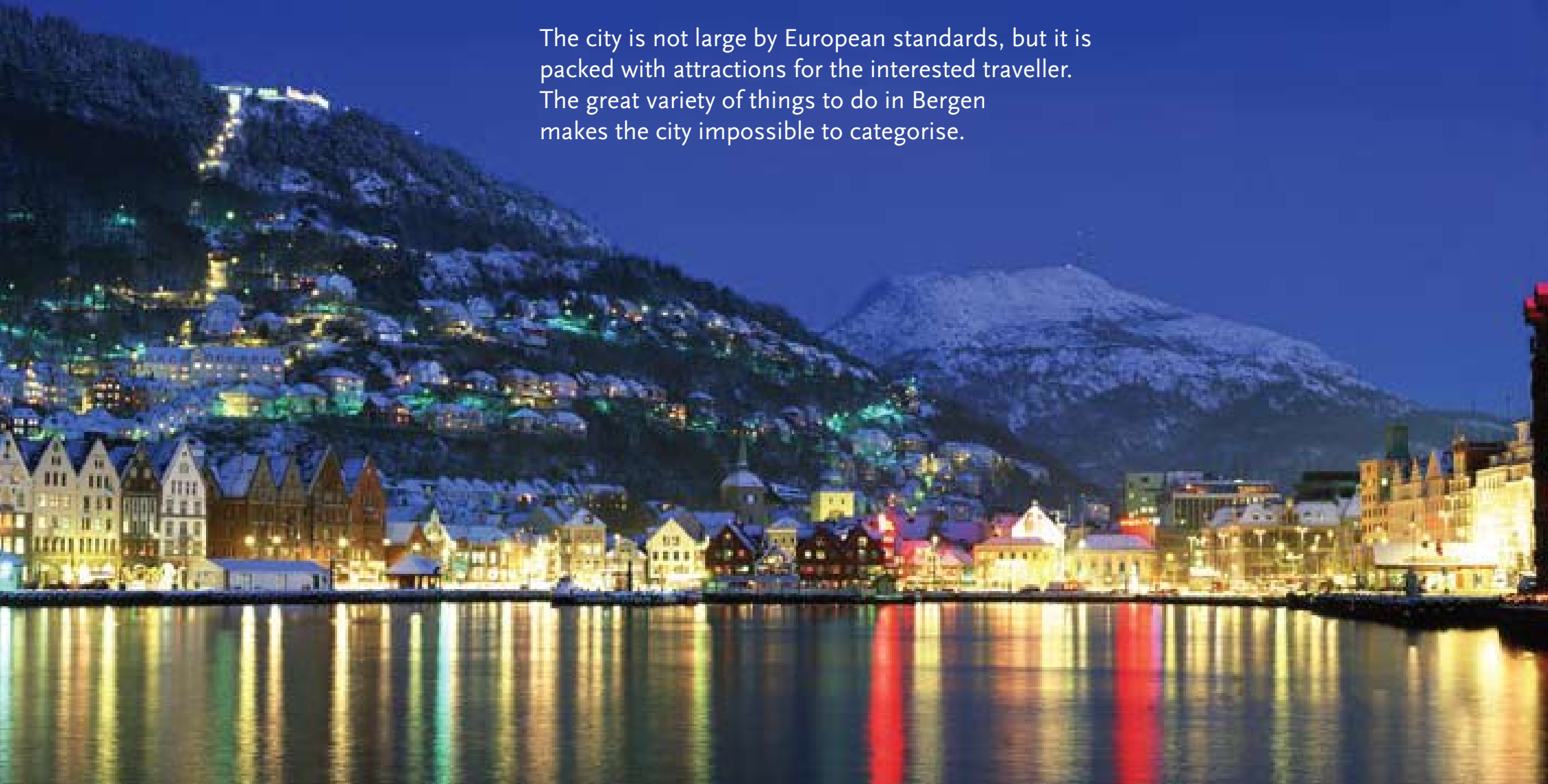

# Flåm - Norway in a nutshell

## “Fjord, mountain and World Heritage Site”

The Sognefjord with its many fjord arms has been a highlight and main attraction for cruise tourists along the Norwegian coast for many decades. The Nærøyfjord is the most spectacular fjord arm of the Sognefjord and is listed on UNESCO's World Heritage List.







The Flåm Railway is one of the most famous and spectacular train journeys in the world, with beautiful mountain scenery, magnificent waterfalls, fertile heritage landscape and historical traditions.

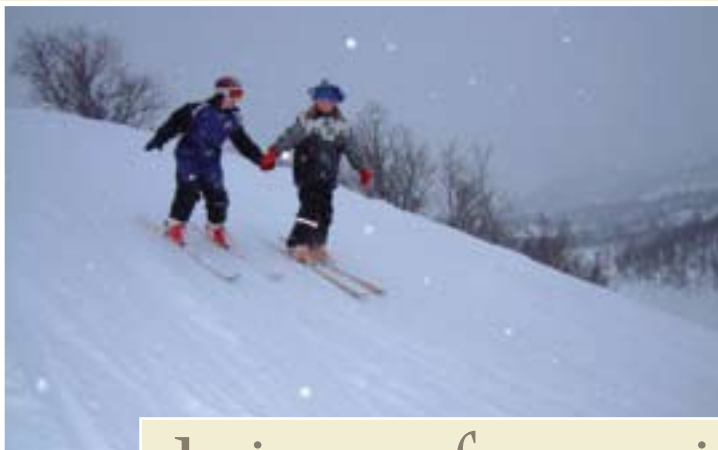

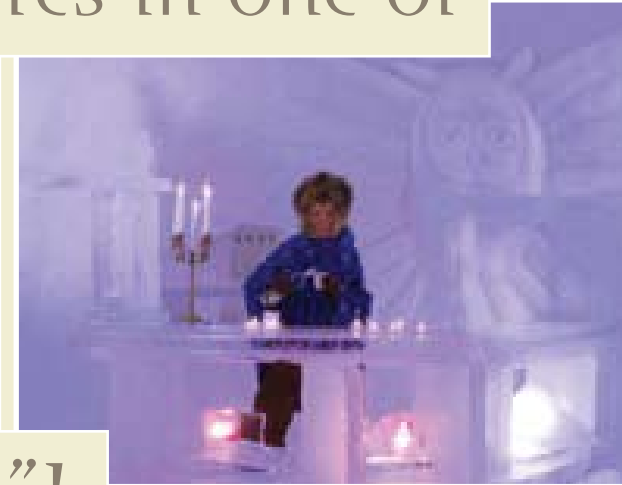
